SUGGESTIONS

Add organic matter

Protect your plants from pests and diseases using organic methods. Harvest your vegetables when they're ripe.

Sow seeds directly in the ground whenever possible. This will help to reduce the risk of transplant shock.

Rotate your crops

This will help to prevent pests and diseases from becoming a problem.

Inter-plant your vegetables

This will help to improve the overall health of your garden and discourage pests.
